Unit Membership is subject to approval of BACCN's Membership Secretary.

The Unit must nominate a main contact person. BACCN will communicate with the Unit in relation to its CCU Membership. Individual members will receive regular membership e mails and members' benefits such as website access and the bimonthly Journal in the usual manner. Any changes to this main contact person must be notified to BACCN as soon as practicable.
