

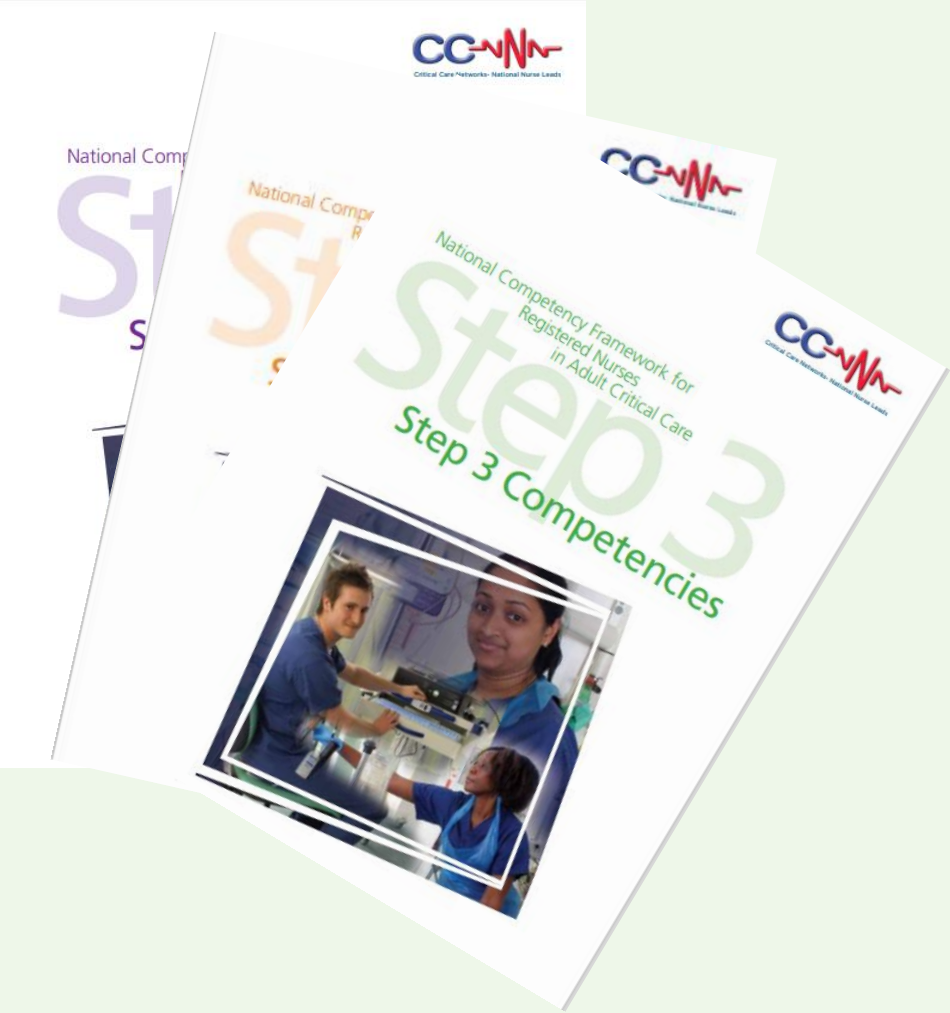

Educator/Lead Nurse Benefits

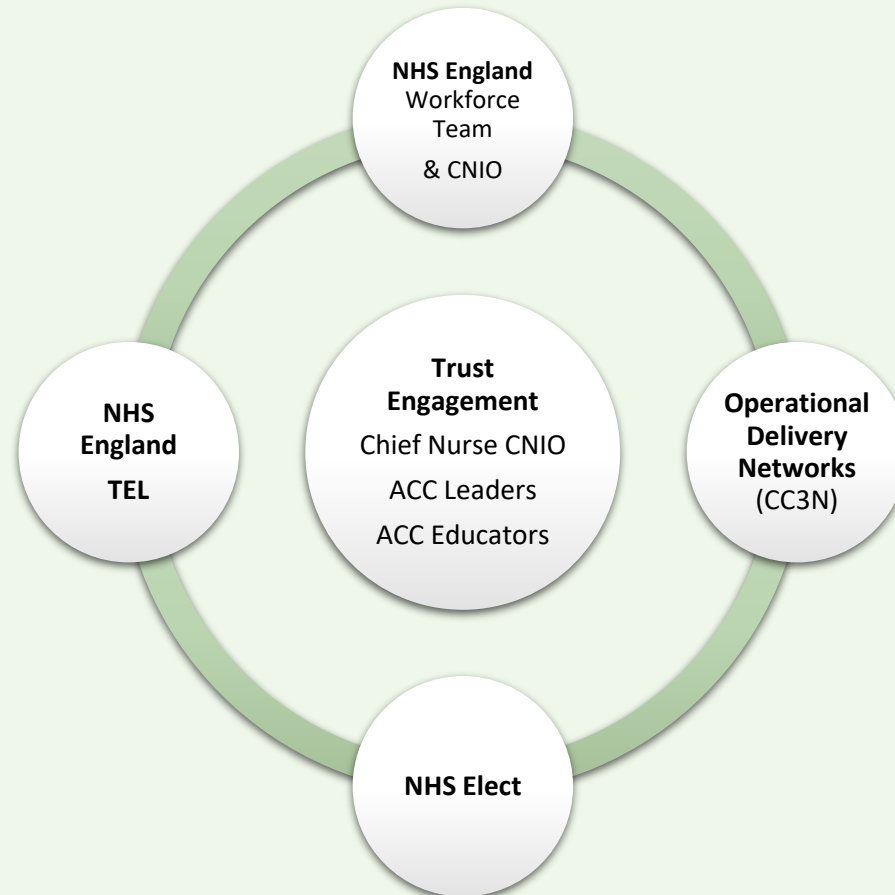
- User reports: Can see progress for each learner without viewing a physical booklet
