## BACCN Conference 2024 Grant Report Catherine Plowright

I was fortunate to receive a grant to attend this conference for which I am extremely grateful. Though I have attended annual BACCN conferences in the past this is the first one in many years that I have attended as a delegate. Thank – you BACCN.

There were many interesting sessions I attended but the key highlights for me were these keynote speakers:

Carli Whittaker who is the current president of the Paediatric Critical Care Society – the first nurse and first female to hold this position - and the Head of Nursing Practice for Children and Young People at the RCN. She gave a thought-provoking keynote presentation about paediatric critical care that made me think about the similarities and differences between adult paediatric critical care and that mutual aid between the two should be considered.

Dr Henrietta Hughes the Patient Safety Commissioner. She told us about her new role promoting patient safety in relation to medicines and medical devices and on promoting the patient voice.
